Requirements to be considered for the CMA Program:

- Must be at least 18 years old
- Possess an accredited High School Diploma or GED®
- Pass the TABE test (Level A) at 10.0 or higher
- Submit a Clinical Medical Assistant Application submitted to the Nursing Department

Upon acceptance into the program the following will be required:

Health Requirements

- Student Health Questionnaire
- Physical Exam Form
- Physical Capacity Form
- Negative TB or chest X-ray (*within 2 months*)
- Flu shot (in current season)
- Physical Examination Form
- Background Check/ Drug Screening
- Immunizations
(TB/ Hepatitis B/ Varicella/ Pertussis/MMR)

Supplies

- Chromebook or Personal Laptop
- 3x5 index cards (*2 pkgs*)
- Ream of copy paper
- 3 ring binder (*paper/ notebook, pens, highlighter*)
- Uniforms (*Galaxy blue tops & khaki bottoms*)
- White Nursing shoes/ khaki socks
- Watch with a second hand

HOW TO GET STARTED

Step 1: Register for the TABE test (\$15.00 fee)

You can register in person in the Nursing and Allied Health Department in room A-8 or register online at Clovisadulthoodeducation.com

- Follow the instructions to sign up.

Step 2: Fill out and submit a CMA Application

You will need a photo I.D and your High School Diploma /GED® when turning in your application
